CERTIFICATE OF FORMATION

Nonprofit Corporation

Corporations Section

Article 1

Entity Type and Name

The filing entity being formed is a nonprofit corporation.

The name of the entity is: Light to the Peoples.

Article 2

Registered Agent and Registered Office

The initial registered agent is an individual resident of the state whose name is set forth below:

Article 3

Management

The management of the affairs of the corporation is vested in the board of trustees. The number of trustees constituting the initial board of directors and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as trustees until the first annual meeting of members or until their successors are elected and qualified are as follows:

Article 4

Membership

The nonprofit corporation, Light to the Peoples, shall have members.

Article 5

Purpose

The nonprofit corporation, Light to the Peoples, is organized for the following purpose or purposes:

- a. Light to the Peoples is organized for exclusively religious, charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- b. The specific purposes for which Light to the Peoples is organized are: to encourage and promote the worship of the living God through Jesus Christ, with the help of the Holy Spirit; to encourage and promote the propagation of the good news of the grace of God in Jesus Christ to all the ethnic people groups of the world, and to

make the peoples of the world the disciples of Jesus Christ by teaching them to obey the message of Jesus Christ as taught in the Holy Bible, consisting of sixty-six books; to edify the believers in Jesus Christ and to equip them for the work of the ministry; to advocate and advance fellowship among the disciples of Jesus Christ; and, to respond to human need with acts and activities of compassion.

Article 6

Non-exempt Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, Light to the Peoples shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any United States Internal Revenue Law or by organization, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Section corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 7

Political and Legislative Activities

No substantial part of the activities of Light to the Peoples shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization

shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article 8

Nonprofit

No part of the net earnings of Light to the Peoples shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any trustee, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

Article 9

Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, at the recommendation of the members, the Board of Trustees, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, shall dispose of the

residual assets of the corporation exclusively for one or more exempt purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding Sections of any future Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
